YEAR 7 LEARNING PROGRAMME

The Year 7 curriculum builds upon the skills, knowledge and understanding learnt in primary school. Our exciting skills-based programme will help students to develop as:

These skills will be taught in Personal Development Curriculum (PDC) time and are developed through subject lessons.

Students will follow the National Curriculum, taught by specialist teachers:
